House of India is a non-profit organization whose primary purpose is dedicated towards creating a greater awareness of India's rich culture, traditions, history, and heritage in the San Diego community and beyond. The organization is now pursuing avenues to raise funds for building a cottage in **Balboa Park** (the nation's largest urban cultural park, home to 15 major museums, renowned performing arts venues, beautiful gardens, and the San Diego Zoo). The HOI cottage will be situated in a premium location amidst nineteen other International Cottages.

We have successfully received permission from important Departments of the City Council to build the cottage. We hope to get clearance from just a few more agencies (which at this point are a mere formality) and break ground by December, 2015. A permanent cottage will provide a year-round venue for showcasing India's art, history, music, dance, and ethnic food. Additionally, the facility can be used by the local Indian community for various other purposes like community gatherings. **The cottage will be a lasting symbolic representation of the strength of the Indian community in San Diego and a legacy to future generations.**

The HOI is raising \$300,000 to turn our vision of a cottage into a reality. Contributions of \$5,000 or more will be acknowledged in a special way in the cottage.
